

Recognised Teacher Award

Six Requirements



Recognised Teachers have obtained their award in at least one of the following categories:

- Recognised Dance Teacher
- Recognised Dance and Musical Theatre Teacher
- Recognised Drama and Musical Theatre Teacher
- Recognised Drama Teacher

Applicants for CDMT's Recognised Teacher Award must confirm that they comply with the following Requirements at the time of applications and for so long as they hold the Recognised Teacher status. Namely, that they:

- Have and adhere to appropriate **Professional Policies and Procedures** in respect of the following: Health & Safety, Safeguarding, Equal Opportunities and Customer Service (including feedback and complaints)
- Hold and adhere to a **Children and Adults at Risk Protection Policy** and hold an **Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS)** check (or equivalent where available).
- Hold appropriate and adequate **Insurance**
- Adhere to the **CDMT Code of Professional Conduct and Practice** or recognised equivalent
- Make the **Six Requirements for Recognised Teachers** document publically available, together with the following **Key Information**: full routine and emergency contact details, timetables, details of venues and examinations, public performances, competitions and/or displays
- Hold a CDMT, Ofqual or other government-recognised **Teaching Qualification** at RQF Level 3 or above or hold a performance-based degree and Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) or Qualified Teacher Learning Status (QTLS).
